• RESOLUTION NO. /9 FOR 1925.

WHEREAS THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON has heretofore deemed it expedient and necessary and ordered the improvement of the following described street, to-wit:

Second Street between the South line of Grant Street and the North line of Tangent Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon,

by pairing the same full width from curb line to curb line with either:

- (a) Asphaltic concrete 2 inch top on 4 inch crushed rock or crushed gravel base;
- (b) Portland cement concrete, 6 inches thick;
- (c) Portland Cement concrete, 7 inches thick;
- (d) Warrenite Bitulithic 2 inch top, 4 inch crushed rock base;
- (e) Warrenite Bitulithic $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch top on $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch bituminous base.

And Whereas, after due publication of notice calling for bids upon said work as proposed, and as required by the ordinances and the Charter of the said City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, bids have been submitted for the performance and completion of said work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Lebanon,Linn County,Oregon, deems it best for all concerned and most advantageous for the people of the City of Lebanon and especially to those owning property particularly and specifically benefitted thereby, that such improvement be made by paving said street with the tipe known as Warrenite-Bitulithia $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch top $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch Bituminous base according to he plans and specifications prepared and submitted by Engineer K.A. Sinclair and now on file with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Linn County,Oregon. NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the following described street, to-wit:

Second street between the South line of Grant Street and the North line of Tangent Street, in said City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon,

be paved with Warrenite-Bitulithic $l\frac{1}{2}$ inch top $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch bituminous base.
