

RESOLUTION NO. 22 For 1925.

WHEREAS, such proceedings have been had by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, that have resulted in the paving by the City of Lebanon of certain streets in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, during the summer of 1925, and

WHEREAS, the said City has levied an assessment against the property abutting upon, adjacent to and especially benefited by said improvement, and, whereas, the owner of property abutting upon, adjacent to and especially benefited by said improvement, have filed with the City Recorder of said City applications for payment of said assessment in ten equal installments according to the provision of the law, known as the Bancroft Bonding Act, and whereas, all proceedings have been duly and regularly had for the improvement of said streets and the said City has authorized the sale of improvement bonds of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, in a sum equal to the amount of said applications, and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given by City Recorder of said City calling for bids for said bonds, and whereas, at the time and place set for submitting bids for said bonds

The First National Bank of Lebanon
submitted the highest responsible bid therefor and its bid was the best and highest responsible bid.

THEREFORE be it resolved that the bid of

be and the same is hereby accepted and that said bonds be and the same are hereby sold to The First National Bank of Lebanon

and the City Recorder is hereby authorized, directed and empowered to have said bonds printed and to procure the opinion of a standard bond attorney, which said opinion is to be furnished the said successful bidder.
