

Resolution No. 2 for 1927.

Whereas the superintendent of Streets of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, has reported in writing to the City Council that sidewalks should be built in said City as follows:

(1) On the North side of Maple street abutting on the south end of lots 6 & 7 block 3 J.M. Ralston's Third Addition to Lebanon, Oregon and extending to the curb line on the East side of Park Street; and also on the east side of Park Street abutting upon and adjacent to lot six and the South 33 feet of Lot 5 in said block 3 of said addition, and extending to the curb line on the North side of Maple street, the reputed owner of said lots and walks being T.W. Seek.

(2) On the west side of Grove Street abutting upon lot 3 in block 22, J.M. Ralston's addition to Lebanon, Oregon, belonging to Sheridan Long.

(3) On the North side of Grant Street abutting upon the following described property, to-wit:- Beginning at a point 1572.6 feet east and 200.5 feet south of the Northwest corner of block 26, J.M. Ralston's addition to Lebanon, Oregon; running thence south 188 feet, more or less, to the North side of Grant Street; thence southeasterly along the North side of Grant Street 362 feet, more or less, to the West side of Walnut street; thence North along the West side of said Walnut Street 215.2 feet to a point east of the place of beginning; thence west 242 feet to the point of beginning. The owner or reputed owner of the East 225 feet of said property is Glen L. Tucker and the owner or reputed owner of the West 137 feet of said property is L.A. Tucker and Edna Tucker.

(4) On the West side of Hiatt Street abutting upon the East end of Lot 7, block 2, Kirkpatrick's Third addition to Lebanon, Oregon, and extending to the curb line on the South side of Isabella Street; and also on the North side of Isabella Street abutting upon the South side of said lot 7 and extending to the curb line on the West side of Hiatt Street. The owner or reputed owner thereof is Wester Alley.

(5) On the North side of Elmore Street abutting upon the following described tract of land, to-wit:- Beginning at a point which is 20 feet North of the Northeast corner of block 26 in William Ralston's Addition to the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and running thence east 77.5 feet along the North line of Elmore street; thence North 223.5 feet; thence west 77.5 feet; thence South 223.5 feet to the place of beginning; the owner or reputed owner thereof being Alma T. Morris.

And Whereas the said superintendent of streets and the committee on streets and public property of the Council report that the present walks now abutting upon and adjacent to said several described properties are old, rotten and dangerous for travel thereon and are so badly decayed that they can not be repaired, and

WHEREAS the Council finds and determines that each of said present side walks abutting upon and adjacent to said several properties is old, rotten and dangerous for travel thereon, and that each thereof accommodates a large number of persons, and that each of said walks is a necessary walk for the accommodation of the citizens of Lebanon, and

Whereas the Council finds and ascertains that all of said above described walks, except the walk last described as belonging to Alma T. Morris, and that part of the walk described as belongin to Hester Alley that abuts upon the East end of Lot 7, block 2 Kirkpatrick's Third addition to Lebanon, are within the cement sidewalk district of said City of Lebanon, as described and designated by Ordinance No. 293 of the said City, and that said two exceptions are without the said cement sidewalk district, and that all of said sidewalks should be constructed within as short a time as possible for the safety of the public, and

Whereas the Council finds and determines that the owners or reputed owners of said several properties are as set out above, and that the postoffice addresses of said several persons owning said properties are as follows: ~~Ray Spack, Lebanon,~~ Oregon; Sheridan Long, *Jillamook, Or.*; Glen L. Tucker, and L.A. Tucker and Emma Tucker, Lebanon, Oregon; Hester Alley, ; and Alma T. Morris, Prineville, Oregon.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, that the owner or owners of the above described lots and parcels of land and the side walks abutting thereon, as herein above described, shall each construct or cause to be constructed a cement concrete sidewalk abutting upon his said described lot or parcel of land as above provided, which said walks shall each be 5 ~~feet~~ feet wide and constructed of cement, sand and gravel of the proper proportions to make a good cement or concrete sidewalk, which said walks shall be built on the established grade of the said City; except that the said Alma T. Morris may construct a board walk abutting upon his

said premises as above described, and the said Hester Alley may
construct a board walk along ^{the East end of} her said premises which abut upon
Hiatt Street *which said board walks shall be 5 1/3 feet.*

Be it further resolved that the Council finds and ascertains
and determines that the owners or reputed owners of said several
lots or parcels of land and their post office addresses are as
above set out; and

Be it further resolved that each of said walks be constructed
within thirty days from the date of this resolution and that
said walks that are required to be constructed of cement, sand and
gravel be constructed in accordance with the ordinance now in
effect relating to the construction of being Ordinance No. 74 cement sidewalks, and that
the said walks that may be constructed of lumber be constructed
in accordance with ordinance No. 74 relating to the con-
struction of walks made from lumber.; and

Be it further resolved that notice to construct said side-
walks be given to the respective owners thereof and the owner of
the abutting property, in the manner provided by section 223 of the
charter of the said City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, now in
force; and

Be it further resolved that said sidewalks and each of them be
constructed without furnishing plans and specifications therefor by
the owner or owners thereof respectively.; and

Be it further resolved that if the said owner or owners or ^{thereof} any/
of said lots or parcels of land, or any part thereof, shall fail,
refuse, or neglect to construct the same within the time herein
ordered, then the superintendent of streets of the said City of
Lebanon shall construct the same or cause the same to be constructed
as provided by the charter of the said city of Lebanon and the
ordinances thereof and keep an accurate account of the cost of
labor and materials used in the building of ~~each~~ each such walk so
constructed, and shall report, as soon as completed, the cost thereof,
together with the description of the lot or parcel of land front-

ing on said walk so constructed, which said report shall be in writing and filed with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon.
