## RESOLUTION NO. 2 FOR 1928.

## RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF MAPLE STREET FROM THE EAST LINE OF WILLIAMS STREET TO THE WEST LINE OF HIATT STREET IN LEBANON, OREGON, AND PROVIDING FOR THE IM-PROVEMENT OF SAID PART OF SAID STREET.

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon deems it expedient to improvement certain streets in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, there is on file with theRecorder of said City of Lebanon a petition praying for the improvement of Maple Street between the East line of Williams Street and the West line of Hiatt Street in said City, and it appearing to the Council, from said petition, that the same is fully signed by a majority of the owners of all of the abutting property on that part of said street to be improved and especially benefited thereby, and after due investigation, the Council finds that said petition is duly signed by a majority of all owners of the property abutting on said proposed improvement and also the property especially benefited thereby; and

WHEREAS, the Council did, on the  $\mathcal{J}^{a}$  day of  $\mathcal{W}_{mil}$ 1928, duly adopt and pass a resolution requiring the City Engineer and the City Superintendent of Streets to prepare plans and specifications and estimates of the probable total cost of said improvement, which said plans and specifications and estimates were, on the first day of May, 1928, duly filed with the Recorder of said City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, that the said Council deems it expedient and for the best interests of the City of Lebanon to improve the above described part of Maple Street by grading the road way of said Street to proper subgrade; by surfacing the road way with crushed river gravel for a width of twelve feet and of sufficient thickness to make a substantial all weather road way;

and by making proper drainage for the said street; and that said improvement be made and done in accordance with the provisions of the charter of the City of Lebanon relating to the improvement of streets and in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon, known as the "Bancroft Bonding Act" and in accordance with the plans and specifications of the City Engineer and the Superintendent of Streets now on file with the Recorder of said City and marked: "Plans andSpecifications and Estimates for the improvement of Maple Street between the East line of Williams Street to the West line of Hiatt Street".

That the cost of the grading and draining said Street be done and paid by the City of Lebanon out of any funds available for that purpose and that the cost of surfacing and other cost in connection with said improvement be paid for by the owners of the abutting real property, and the owners of the real property especially benefited thereby.

That the City Engineer and Street Superintendent of said City file with the Recorder of said City their plans and specifications and estimates of the probable total cost of the said improvement in the sum of Ninety Dollars and the sum thereof to be paid by the City of Lebanon is the sum of Twenty-five Dollars and the sum thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the real property especially benefited thereby is the sum of Sixty-five Dollars.

That the said plans and specifications and estimates of the probable total cost of said improvement are hereby, in all things, approved, ratified and affirmed; and

WHEREAS, there is on file with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon in this matter a petition duly signed by a majority of the owners of all the real property abutting upon the said proposed improvement and the real property especially benefited thereby asking for said improvement and that the same be made without asking for any bids therefor and that no bids be received or had for the same and that the City of Lebanon do, or cause the same to be done and made, and that no further notice be given of the intention to make the same or of the making of the same and that each and all, jointly and severally, waive all further and additional notice in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE FURTHER RESOLVED that by reason of the said petition and the matters herein setout, the city has acquired jurisdiction to make the said improvement in accordance with the said petition and said plans and specifications and estimates; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Street Superintendent and Engineer proceed to make the said improvement in accordance with the said petition andthe charter of said City and law governing the same and that they make and file a report in writing, when the said work is completed, of all work done and the cost thereof against each lot and parcel of land.
