Resolution No. 7 for 1928.

WHEREAS, heretofore and on the 4th day of September, 1928, upon a report of the Street Superintendent theretofore duly made and filed, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon duly passed Resolution No. 4 for 1928 in which said Council found and ascertained that a new cenent sidewalk, of regulation width, should be constructed along the South line of Tangent Street abutting upon Lot 14, Parkview Subdivision to Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and that said walk was within the cenent sidewalk district of said city and which said resolution further directed that proper notice to the owner or owners of said lot be given, ordering said sidewalk to be constructed within a specified time, and failing so to do that the Street Superintendent built the same and reported the cost thereof to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the owner of said lot, after due notice given as in said resolution provided, failed to construct said walk; and

WHEREAS, the said Street Superintendent has caused the same to be constructed in the manner provided by the charter of the City of Lebanon and the ordinances in force governing the construction of cement sidewalks in said city and has duly reported to the Council the cost of the labor and materials in building the same; and

WHEREAS, said report appears to be in proper form and approved by the Street Cormittee and that the cost of said construction appears to be reasonable and just and that appears ment should be levied against said lot for the cost thereof, and that a time should be set for the levying of said assessment and that notice of the time and place when and where said assessment would be levied should be given to the owner, and all persons interested in said lot, so that they might have an opportunity to be present and object to such levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT Resolved that the time for hearing objections, if any, to the levying of said assessment, be and the same is hereby set for Tuesday, January 15th, 1929, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.H. thereof, at the Council Chamber at , Lebanon, Oregon, and that notice of such hearing be given by posting copies thereof in three of the most public places in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and by mailing a copy of such notice to said owner at his post office address, to-wit:

That said posting be for a period of ten days consecutive

ly prior to the 15th day of January, 1929.
