RESOLUTION NO. 1
FOR 1929.

WHEREAS, Frank Gleason has duly filed herein his verified petition asking for the vacation of that part of B and C Streets lying between Third and Fourth Streets in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; and

It appearing from said petition, and after a thorough investigation, that the said Frank Gleason is the owner of all the land abutting upon each side of the parts of said streets asked to be vacated; and

It further appearing that the said petitioner is now erecting upon the lots abutting upon and adjacent to said parts of said streets a sawmill, which, when completed, will furnish a large payroll and will be very beneficial to the people of the City of Lebanon; and

It further appearing that said parts of said streets asked to be vacated in said petition are not improved and are not in general use by the public and are not necessary arteries of travel and that the vacation thereof will be beneficial to the people of the City of Lebanon.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, that said petition be and the same is hereby set for hearing on the 2nd day of July, 1929, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. of said day at the Council Chamber in said City of Lebanon, Oregon, and that all persons desiring to object or remonstrate to the said petition or to

the vacation of said portions of said streets, filing such objection or remonstrance with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, on or before said time and that such objections or remonstrances, if any there be, be heard and considered at said time and place.

And be it further resolved that the Recorder of the City of Lebanon be and he is hereby directed to give due and legal notice to all persons concerned of the time and place of said hearing by posting notices in four public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, at such places as legal notices are usually posted in said City, which said notices shall be posted for, at least, thirty days before the time fixed and set for said hearing, as herein above stated; and

Be it further resolved that if no objections or remonstrances are made or filed against the said petition or against the vacation of the said portion of said streets that the same be taken as confessed and the said petition and the vacation of said parts of said streets will be granted as prayed for.

Passed by the Council this 23rd day of May, 1929, by an affirmative vote of a majority of all members of the Council on roll call and entered in the Journal of the proceedings of the Council.

Approved by the Mayor this 23rd day of May, 1929.
