

RESOLUTION NO. 8 FOR 1929.

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE PURPOSE AND INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO LAY A LATERAL SEWER ON ELMORE STREET CONNECTING WITH THE MAIN TRUNK SEWER WHERE THE SAME CROSSES SAID ELMORE STREET AND EXTENDING EAST A DISTANCE OF 619 FEET.

WHEREAS the City Council of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, did at its regular meeting held at the Council Chambers on the 1st day of October, 1929, require and direct the City Engineer to prepare plans and specifications for the laying of a lateral sewer on Elmore Street connecting with the trunk sewer at a point where the same crosses said Elmore street and extending east a distance of 619 feet, *More or less* and

WHEREAS said City Engineer has prepared, and filed with the City Recorder, plans, specifications and estimates giving the estimate of the work to be done and the cost thereof, for the laying of said lateral sewer, and

WHEREAS the Council, by Resolution No. 7 for 1929, duly approved said plans, specifications and estimates, on the 15th day of October, 1929, and

WHEREAS the said Council deems it necessary and expedient to construct said lateral sewer and that the cost thereof be assessed against the property benefited thereby,

THEREFORE be it resolved that it is the purpose and intent of the City Council to construct a lateral sewer according to said plans and specifications, connecting with the main Trunk sewer where the same crosses Elmore Street in said City of Lebanon, and extending eastward a distance of 619 feet, *More or less* said work to be commenced and completed in the shortest time possible, consistent with good workmanship.

Be it further resolved that notice of the intention of the Council to construct said lateral sewer be given as provided by the Charter of said City of Lebanon now in force.
