

RESOLUTION 1 FOR 1930.

WHEREAS, during the construction of the improvement of Second Street and West Grant Street in 1925, the City Treasurer, through misinterpretation of the instruction of the Council paid money belonging in The Sewer Bond Sinking *fund* for City Warrents issued to pay for said improvements; and of the amount so paid, the sum of Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars has not been returned to said fund.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Treasurer and Recorder be authorized and instructed to transfer from any funds available to the Sewer Bond Sinking Fund the sum of Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars; and to invest the same in City of Lebanon Improvement Bonds #16 to 23 inclusive Series Aug. 12, 1925; and to invest any balance in said fund or in the Dike and Improvement Sinking Fund in City of Lebanon Improvement Bond, series Sept. 2, 1926, and report at the next meeting of the Council.
