

RESOLUTION NO. 4 for 1930.

WHEREAS THE CITY OF LEBANON, Linn County, Oregon,
is the owner of the following described real property, situated
in Linn County, Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning at a point which is South 354 feet distant
from the North boundary line of William Ralston's
Donation land claim, known on plats of U.S. Surveys
as Not. No. 2307, Claim No. 48 in Tp. 12, South Range
Two West of the Willamette Meridian and being on line
with the West side of Second Street produced to the
South, in the Town of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and
running from thence South 264 feet, thence West 330
feet; thence North 264 feet, thence East 330 feet to
the place of beginning and containing Two acres.

WHEREAS said land is not needed for public at this time
and will not be needed for public use; and

WHEREAS the Council deems it to the best interest of
said City that said land be sold and that the same can be
sold to the best interest of the City by a private sale thereof,

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Superintendent of
Streets, R. Oldham, be and he is hereby authorized and direc-
ted to sell said above described real property at private
sale for Cash in hand to the highest and best bidder therefor;
and it is further ordered that due and legal notice of said
proposed sale of said land be given by publication in the
Lebanon Express for four weeks prior to the date of making such
sale, in the manner provided by the City Charter for making
sales of real property of said City. Provided, that any
such sale be made subject to confirmation by the City Council.
