Resolution no 3. for 1932

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY ENGINEER AND STREET SUPERINTENDENT TP PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF VINE STREET FROM THE WEST LINE OF GROVE STREET TO THE WEST LINE OF WILLIAMS STREET IN LEBANON LINE COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon deems it expedient and for the best interest of the said city to improve certain streets of the said city by grading the same to the proper sub grade, and by surfacing the roadway of said streets with crushed rock or crushed gravel, and

WHEREAS, there is a petition on file with the recorder of the said city of Lebanon praying for the improvement of Vine street from the West line of Grove street to the West line of Williams street;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, requires of the Street Superintendent and the City Engineer of said City plans, specifications, and estimates of the probable total cost of the improvement of the part of said street aforesaid, and that said improvement be made in the following manner:

- (1) By grading the roadway of said street to proper subgrade.
- (2) By graveling or surfacing the roadway of said street for a width of twelve feet in the center thereof, with crushed rock or crushed river gravel of sufficient thickness to make a good substantial road.
- (3) By making proper drainage for said street.

That the grading of said street be done by and at the expense of the City of Lebanon, and that the same be paid for out of the road or general fund or other available fund of said City.

That the surfacing of said street with crushed rock or crushed river gravel be done at the expense of the owners of the abbuting real property and the real property especially benefitted thereby, and the cost thereof be made a lien upon and acharge against said property. That said plansand specifications be filed on or before April \boldsymbol{q} ,1932.
