RESOLUTION NO. 7 FOR 1933.

WHEREAS, in the repair of Main Street in the city of Lebanon, Oregon, under the Civil Works Act (CWA) by removing seven (7) feet of Bithulitic pavement adjacent to the curb on each side of said street and replacing the same with concrete, the ratio of labor and materials established by said federal agency will not be sufficient to pay all the cost of the material necessary to complete said project, and

WHEREAS, other projects for the improvements of streets of the City of Lebanon are being carried on under the same arrangement with federal agencies,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED That out of the funds of the City of Lebanon not otherwise appropriated the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.) be set aside for the purpose of using so much thereof as shall be necessary for the completion of the repairs to said streets of said city.
