

RESOLUTION NO. 10 FOR 1934.

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Oregon, is about to lay a lateral sewer extension from Main Street West on North Main Street and Morton Streets to Second Street, North on Second Street to Mary Street and West on Harrison Street from Second Street to Third Street, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to the federal government to furnish the labor on said project with the understanding that the property owners abutting which said sewer shall run shall pay the other costs in connection therewith,

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City Treasurer and City Recorder be and they are hereby authorized and directed to set aside the sum of \$ 1200⁰⁰ from funds not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of paying for materials and supplies, the contribution to the State Industrial Accident Commission for the labor used, and for the cost of supervising the construction of said sewer.
