

RESOLUTION NO. 8 FOR 1936.

WHEREAS, Linn County, Oregon, has foreclosed its lien for delinquent taxes on the following described property, to-wit:

Lots 1, 2, and 3, in Block 2, Wassom's Addition to Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon,

And

WHEREAS, said County has been offered the sum of \$149.16 for said property and has notified the City of Lebanon of its right to purchase said land from said County in case said City should have an unpaid lien thereon for local improvements, and

WHEREAS, The City of Lebanon has an unpaid lien thereon for local improvements in the sum of \$306.00, together with interest thereon at the rate of $5\frac{1}{2}\%$ per annum from the 12th day of August, 1925.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the City Recorder be and he is hereby authorized to issue a warrant on the City Treasurer on funds not otherwise appropriated, payable to R. M. Russell, Linn County Clerk, the sum of \$149.16, together with accruing costs incurred by said County, if any, for the purchase of said property from said County.
