

RESOLUTION NO. 13 FOR 1936

WHEREAS, The Fire Department Committee of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, has investigated fire pumpers suitable for the purchase and use of the City of Lebanon, and

WHEREAS, Said Committee has recommended the purchase of a Seagrave Fire Engine No. 8 from the Seagrave Corporation of Columbus, Ohio, which said Corporation offers to build upon the specifications submitted to it by the fire chief of said City and deliver to said City for the price of \$7927.50, or, if cash is paid at the time of delivery, for a discount of 5%, making the purchase price thereof the sum of \$7531.13, and

WHEREAS, Howard-Cooper Corporation, Oregon agent for said Seagrave Corporation, has also offered to remodel the Model A, Ford Fire Truck of said City by adding booster equipment and doing such other work thereon as has been specified for the price of \$619.70, and said Committee has recommended the remodeling of said truck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Fire Department Committee of the Common Council of Lebanon, Oregon, composed of Councilmen, L. E. Heyne, as Chairman, M. L. Southard and J. C. Zimbrick, as members, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute in behalf of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a contract with the Seagrave Corporation of Columbus, Ohio, for the purchase of a Seagrave Fire Engine, Model No. 8, according to the specifications as submitted by said Corporation and in conformity with the requirements of the fire chief of said City, for the purchase price of \$7531.13 cash, taking advantage of the 5% discount offered.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said Fire Department Committee be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute in behalf of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a contract

with the Howard-Cooper Corporation, Oregon agent for said Seagrave Corporation, of Columbus, Ohio, for the remodeling and adding of a booster to the Model A Ford Fire Truck of said City in accordance with the specifications heretofore made by said Corporation and the requirements made by the fire chief of said City, for the contract price of \$619.70.
