

RESOLUTION NO. 15 FOR 1936.

A RESOLUTION DECLARING ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF MAPLE STREET BETWEEN THE WEST LINE OF SECOND STREET AND THE EAST LINE OF THIRD STREET IN LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, there was filed with the Council of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, on the 3^d day of ~~August~~^{Sept}, 1935, a petition of a majority of the property owners in said improvement district requesting the grading and gravelling of the street in said improvement district and agreeing to pay their proportionate share of covering said street with crushed rock, and

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of September, 1935, the Common Council of said City duly adopted and enacted Resolution No. 15 for 1935, requiring the City Engineer and Street Superintendent to prepare plans, specifications and estimates of the total probable cost of making said improvement as asked for in said petition then on file, and

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of September, 1935, the said Engineer and Superintendent of Streets filed with the Recorder of said City plans, specifications and estimates of the probable cost of said improvement as requested in said petition and estimates so made of the probable total cost of said improvement was the sum of \$260.00, and that the estimate of the total cost of the improvement to be paid by the said City was the sum of \$110.00, and that the estimate of the probable total cost of said improvement to be paid by the owners of the ^{real} abutting/property, the real property especially benefitted thereby, was the sum of \$150.00, and

WHEREAS, said Council did on the 3rd day of September, 1935, duly adopt a resolution ratifying and approving said plans and specifications so prepared and filed, and authorized said work to be done by said City without advertising for bids for the same as was prayed for in said petition, and

WHEREAS, Said City Engineer and Street Superintendent have made and filed herein their report in writing showing that said improvement has been fully completed in accordance with said petition and in accordance with the plans and specifications adopted therefor, and that the total cost of making said improvement is the sum of \$126.64, and that the sum to be paid by the City of Lebanon is \$28.14 and that the sum to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property, the real property especially benefitted thereby, is the sum of \$98.50.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF SAID CITY That the report of said City Engineer and Street Superintendent be and the same is hereby ratified and approved, and in all respects confirmed, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the total cost of said improvement in said improvement district is the sum of \$126.64 and that the portion thereof to be paid by the City of Lebanon is \$28.14, and that the portion thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property, the real property especially benefitted thereby, is the sum of \$98.50.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT The amount assessed to and against each separate lot and tract of land be and the same is hereby fixed as follows:



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Recorder of the City of Lebanon be and he is hereby directed to enter all liens and assessments in the Docket of City Liens of the City of Lebanon, according to the provisions of this resolution and the charter of the said City, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That as soon as this resolution is passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor that the said Recorder give notice of said assessment and lien to each owner or reputed owner of the said real property as herein described, and give the amount of the said lien and that the same is payable at once, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the assessment roll submitted by the City Engineer and Street Superintendent and attached to their report of the improvement of said streets, be and the same is hereby adopted as the assessment roll for the improvement of said streets and the same is in all things approved, ratified and confirmed and the said assessments are hereby declared a lien against the several parcels, lots and tracts of land therein described and in the amount therein set out.

Adopted by the Common Council on roll call and the vote entered in the minutes of the Council proceedings by unanimous vote of all members present this 21st day of July, 1936.
