

RESOLUTION NO. 19 FOR 1936.

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, by Resolution No. 13 for 1936, adopted on the 7th day of July, 1936, did authorize the Fire Department Committee of said Council to order certain fire equipment for the use of said City, to-wit: 1 model No. 8, Seagrave Fire Engine for the price of \$7619.00, and the remodeling of the Ford Fire Truck now owned by said City at the price of \$531.83, and


WHEREAS, said equipment may be delivered at any time and the purchase price demanded without notice or time allowed for a Council meeting to order the issuance of warrants therefor, and

WHEREAS, Additional equipment may be purchased to use up the difference between the cost of said fire engine and remodeling and the funds received from the sale of Fire Equipment Bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Recorder be and he is hereby authorized to issue and the mayor to sign warrants issued from time to time against the Fire Equipment Fund of said City in an amount not to exceed \$8175.00 upon vouchers signed and presented by the Fire Department Committee of the Council and the Fire Chief.
