HOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Common Council require the City Engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates of the total probably cost of said improving as aforesaid and that the cost thereof be assessed against the property abutting upon said proposed lateral sewer and especially benefitted thereby; that said plans, specifications, and estimates be filed with the Recorder at the earliest possible date.
