

RESOLUTION NO. 10 FOR 1938

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING W.P.A. RESIDENT ENGINEER TO PREPARE A PROJECT FOR THE EXTERMINATION OF RODENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF LEBANON.

WHEREAS, Pocket gophers, moles, and greydigger squirrels are a continual source of annoyance within the City of Lebanon and the same can not be effectively exterminated by individual action, and

WHEREAS, A project for the extermination of said rodents is being carried on in territory adjacent to said City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the W.P. A. Resident Engineer be authorized to prepare a rodent extermination project covering all the area within the city limits of the City of Lebanon in cooperation with a similar project in adjacent territory, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the City Recorder be and he is hereby authorized to draw warrants upon the City Treasurer for payment out of the General Fund, out of money not otherwise appropriated, not to exceed the sum of \$50.00 for payment for materials to be used on said project, and that a room be furnished for use of the personnel and for storage of the materials to be used on said project and the project in the adjoining territory, together with the city's proportionate share of the heat and light for storage of materials and use by the employees on said projects, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That J. A. Dart be and he is hereby appointed to act as a representative of the City on the committee in charge of said project.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 19th day of July, 1938.
