RESOLUTION NO. 14 FOR 1938.

WHEREAS, In accordance with Ordinance No. 2 of the City of Lebanon, the Marshal of said City has filed with the Common Council a report that he finds stagnant water existing on Lot 2, Block 25, William Ralston's Addition to Lebanon, to such an extent as to cause a nuisance and to endanger the health of the citizens of said City residing in the vicinity thereof and that in order to remove the same from said land it is necessary to drain the same, and

WHEREAS, Said City Marshal has reported the names of the owners of said property and estimated the cost of the removal of said stagnant water to be approximately \$ -50.00 and,

WHEREAS, It appears that said report of said City Marshal is true,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the existence of stagnant water on Lot 2, Block 25, William Ralston's Addition to Lebanon, is hereby declared to be a nuisance and to endanger the health of the citizens of said City residing in the vicinity thereof and that it is necessary that said stagnant water be removed by the drainage of said property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the owners of such land, or their agent, be notified in accordance with Section 9 of Ordinance No. 2 of the City of Lebanon to drain said land within ten (10) days from the date hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That should said owners, or their agent, fail, refuse, or neglect to make such drain within the time herein provided, the Marshal let the contract for such work to the lowest responsible bidder, in the manner prescribed by ordinance, and when the work is finished, the cost and expenses thereof be immediately entered in the Book of City Liens in the same manner as provided for entering liens for street improvements.
