RESOLUTION NO. 30 FOR 1938.

WHEREAS, There is available aid from agencies of the Federal Government in the nature of the labor to be supplied for street, sidewalk, and curb construction and repairs, and

WHEREAS, Many property owners in the City of Lebanon desire to take advantage and receive the benefits thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That so long as said

Federal aid is available and the Council deems it advisable

to make such improvements with said Federal aid on property

within the limits of said City, said City shall be and is

hereby declared to be a sidewalk and curb improvement district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That whenever the owner of any property within said City shall make written application to the Council for the repair or construction of any sidewalk, curb, curb gutter, or integral curb and gutter within the City and shall agree to reimburse the City for the cost of the materials used in the construction thereof, in cash, or execute a bond therefor, under the Bancroft Bonding Act, and shall waive the right of remonstrance, the service and publication of notice of intention to build, the calling for bids, and consent to the assessment of the real property upon which said improvements abutt, the said improvement shall be made under the Federal aid project then existing if, in the judgment of the Street Committee of the Council, said improvement is advisable.
