

In the Matter of the Street Improvement District for the Paving of Second Street from the South line of Grant Street to the South line of Maple Street; Maple Street from the East line of Second Street to the East line of Park Street; Park Street from the North line of Maple Street to the North line of Vine Street; Ash Street from the West line of Park Street to the East line of Second Street; Vine Street from the West line of Park Street to the East line of Third Street; Rose Street from the West line of Main Street to the East line of Second Street; Isabella Street from the East line of Main Street to the West line of Park Street; Academy Street from the West line of Main Street to the East line of Second Street; and for the construction of the necessary headers, curbs, and integral curbs and gutters.

RESOLUTION NO. 2
FOR 1939.

WHEREAS, More than fifty (50) percent of the property owners abutting upon said Street Improvement District have filed with the City Recorder of Lebanon, Oregon, their Petition asking for the improvement of said District by paving the streets therein upon the proposition that the property owners shall pay the cost of the materials, and the cost of the labor shall be paid by a grant of Federal funds to the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL That the City Engineer of said City make plans, specifications, and estimates of the total probable cost of said improvement, including the cost of construction of the necessary headers and curbs or integral curbs and gutters, and file the same in the Office of the Recorder.
