PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATE FOR PAVEMENT GROVE STREET FROM SHERMAN TO GRANT STREET LEBANON, OREGON.

It is proposed to lay a concrete pavement 6½" thick and 32 feet wide, in this block. The abutting property owners to pay for the cost of the materials used, and application to be made to the Works Progress Administration for the labor.

The unit costs for materials are as follows:-

Concrets per front foot, 16ft wide -----	\$1.67
Form lumber and nails -----	.05
Expansion joints -----	.20
Dowells -----	.19
Catch basins and sewer connections -----	.30
Equipment -----	.07
Mixer rent -----	.10
Engineering and supervision -----	.10
Total cost per front foot, 16 feet wide ---	\$2.68

Man hours $\frac{6552 \times .75 \times 4}{27} = 728$ for Excavation
 $6552 \times 1 = 6552$ for Paving
 Total-- 7280

Amount to be paid for by abutting property owners ----- \$1097.46

Amount to be paid for by W. P. A. ----- \$2839.20
