Seventh Street, in Lebanon, Linn ) RESOLUTION CALLING FOR  
County, Oregon. ) PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon deems it expedient and for the best interest of the City to improve that portion of B Street from the East line of Fifth Street to the West line of Seventh Street by grading the same to a proper sub-grade, and by surfacing a road-way sixteen (16) feet wide in the center thereof with crushed rock or gravel of sufficient thickness to make a permanent all weather road; and

WHEREAS, There is on file with the Recorder of said City a petition praying for the improvement of said portion of said Street, signed by more than 50% of the abutting property owners,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Common Council of said City require the City Engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates of the total probable cost of said improvement as aforesaid, the improvement to be made in the following manner:

- (1) By grading the roadway to a proper sub-grade.
- (2) By surfacing the said road-way for a width of sixteen (16) feet in the center thereof with crushed rock or gravel of sufficient thickness to make a permanent all weather road.
- (3) By making proper drainage for the street.

That the grading of that portion of B Street above described to proper sub-grade be done at the expense of the City of Lebanon; that the cost of surfacing and other expenses in connection therewith be paid by the property owners of the property adjoining said parts of said streets and abutting thereon, the same being the property especially benefitted thereby, and that the same be made a lien and charge against

said property. That said plans, specifications, and estimates be filed with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon as soon as possible.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 6th day of August, 1940.
