

RESOLUTION NO. 25 FOR 1940


WHEREAS, A vacancy has occurred in the office of Councilman for Ward 1, Lebanon Precinct, by the resignation of Councilman Walter Scott, whose term of office does not expire until December 31, 1942; and

WHEREAS, Said vacancy has occurred after the time for filing nominating petitions for other offices, to be voted upon at the general election of November 5, 1940, but said vacancy has occurred more than twenty (20) days prior to the said general election and the Council has been advised by the City Attorney that said case falls within those mentioned in Article V, Section 16, of the Constitution of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of the Council that said vacancy be filled by the vote of the electors of said ward,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Recorder be and he is hereby authorized to accept ^{until Oct. 15, 1940, inclusive,} nominating petitions for candidates to be voted upon at said general election to fill said unexpired term of said Councilman and that in the preparation of ballots he designate said office as "short term" or by some such appropriate designation or description to prevent the same being confused with the office of Councilman from the same ward for which the term will expire December 31, 1944.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 1st day of October, 1940.
