WHEREAS, the owners of more than fifty per cent of the property abutting upon that certain proposed Street Improvement District consisting of that portion of Rose Street between Second Street and Third Street, in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, have filed with the City Recorder of the said City of Lebanon their Petition asking for the improvement of said District by paving said portion of Rose Street therein described upon the proposition that the property owners shall pay the cost of the materials, and the cost of the labor shall be paid by a grant of Federal funds to the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL That the City Engineer of said city make plans, specifications and estimates of the total probable cost of said improvement, of the probable cost of said work against each separate lot or tract or parcel of land, of the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the property specially benefitting thereby, and of the amount thereof to be borne by the city.
