WHEREAS, the owners of more than fifty per cent of the real property abutting upon that certain proposed Sewer Improvement District, consisting of the property abutting that portion of the alley hereinafter described, said real property being the premises specially benefited by the proposed sewer improvement, have filed with the City Recorder of the City of Lebanon their petition asking for the improvement of said District by the laying of an eight inch Lateral Sewer along an alley as follows, to-wit:


From the intersection of Fifth Street and the alley running between Ash and Vine Street, West along said alley to the East side of Seventh Street, a distance of 805 feet, more or less, in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL that the City Engineer of said City make plans, specification and estimates for said sewer, including the work to be done and the cost thereof together with the probable amount of said cost to be borne and paid by the owners of the abutting property, and each of them, such being the property specially benefited thereby.
