
WHEREAS, the owners of more than fifty per cent of the real property abutting upon that certain proposed Sewer Improvement District, consisting of the property abutting that portion of Cleveland Street hereinafter described, said real property being the premises specially benefitted by the proposed sewer improvement, have filed with the City Recorder of the City of Lebanon their petition asking for the improvement of said District by the laying of an eight inch Lateral Sewer along Cleveland Street/and Grant Street South to Oak Street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL that the City Engineer of said City make plans, specifications and estimates for said sewer, including the work to be done and the cost thereof together with the probable amount of said cost to be borne and paid by the owners of the abutting property, and each of them, such being the property specially benefitted thereby.
