RESOLUTION NO. 82 FOR 1941

Oregon, deems it necessary and advisable and for the best interests of the said City that Milton Street in said City he extended Hastward from Franklin Street unto the City limits, covering the following described land, to-wit:

A strip of land 40 feet in width, lying 20 feet on each side of the center line of Milton Street as extended from the center line of Franklin Street Mestwerd in the present direction of the said milton Street to the East boundary line of the City of Lebanon, said land lying and being within the said City of Lebanon. Linn County, Oregon; and

executed good and sufficient deeds of said strip of land unto the said City of Lebanon upon the condition that said City shell, without delay, erade and gravel a street 8 feet in width along each side of the center line of said strip. Said work to be done solely at the expense of soid City and no assessment or other charge therefor to be made or levied against the owners of the ajecent or abutting property; and

of land is by spid deeds offered unto spid City, save and except, only the interest of the Federal Land Bank Commissioner, as northeader, to small portion of spid strip, spid northeader indicating that his mortgage, as to spid strip, with be released upon compliance with certain formalities; and

"HEREAS, certain private citizens have offered to supply the necessary gravel for said graveling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY PESOLVED. That the Street committee of said council make final arrangements for the graveling of said street as hereinabove specified and that hupon each and every one of said deeds be accepted and the City Recorder

be instructed to file the same for record in the office of the Recorder of Conveyances of and for Linn County, Oregon.

HE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the completion of said arrangements, the said strip of land be graded at the sole expose of said city and that gravel be laid thereupon to a width of 10 feet upon each side of the center line of said strip.
