WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon deems it expedient and for the best interests of said City to improve Oak Street from the West line of Second Street, Westerly to the City limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, by grading the same to the proper sub-grade and by surfacing a roadway twenty feet wide in the center of said Street with crushed rock suitable for the oiling thereof and of sufficient thickness to make a permanent all weather road and by oiling and hard surfacing the same; and whereas there is on file with the recorder of said City a petition asking for the improvement of said portion of Oak Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Council of said City of Lebanon require the City Engineer to prepare plans, specifications and estimates of said improvements, including any necessary provisions for the proper drainage of the street, and of the total probable cost of said improvement as aforesaid, the portion thereof to be borne by the City and the portion thereof to be assessed against each separate lot, tract, and parcel of land abutting upon said portion of Oak Street.

That the cost of said grading be paid by the City of Lebanon and that all other costs and expenses of said improvement be borne and paid by the owners of the property adjacent to and abutting upon said portion of Oak Street, said property being that especially benefitted thereby, and that the same be made a lien and charge against said property. That said plans, specifications and estimates be filed with the recorder of said City at the earliest possible date.
