RESOLUTION NO. 28 FOR 1941

RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS
AND SPECIFICATIONS.

THEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon
deems it expedient and for the best interests of said City to
improve Oak Street, from the West line of Second Street, West to
the City limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, all
within said City; and

THEREAS, There is on file with the Recorder of said
City a written petition signed by the owners of more than one-half
of the real property abutting upon said portion of Oak Street,
praying for the improvement thereof; and

THEREAS, in the judgment of the Common Council said
portion of Oak Street is in such condition as to be unsafe and
dangerous to persons and teams and vehicles passing along and
over the same.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That said plans,
specifications and estimates of the probable total cost of said
improvements, and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the
owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the
property specially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof
to be borne by the City, be and they hereby are in all respects
approved, ratified and affirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said improvements are
and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for the
best interest of the City of Lebanon; and that said improvements
be commenced forthwith, without any further notice thereof being
given.
