RESOLUTION NO. 33 FOR 1941 RESOLUTION CALLING FOR PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

WHEREAS, there is on file with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon a Petition signed by the owners of more than fifty per cent of the property abutting upon the above entitled street improvement district; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon deems it proper, expedient, and for the best interests of said City to improve C Street, from the West line of Fourth Street to the East line of Fifth Street in said City, by grading and surfacing the same in the manner provided by ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Common Council of said City require the City Engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates of said improvement, and the cost thereof, the improvement to be made in the following manner:

- (1) By grading the road-way to a proper sub-grade.
- (2) By surfacing the said road-way for a width of sixteen (16) feet in the center thereof with crushed rock or gravel of sufficient thickness to make a permanent all weather road.
- (3) By making proper drainage for the street.

That the grading of that portion of C Street above described to proper sub-grade be done at the expense of the City of Lebanon; that the cost of surfacing and other expenses in connection therewith be paid by the property owners of the property adjoining said parts of said street and abutting thereon, the same being the property especially benefitted thereby, and that the same be made a lien and charge against said property. That said plans, specifications, and estimates set forth and state the probable cost of said work against each separate lot or tract or parcel of land, and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property,
