WHEREAS there is on file with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon a Petition signed by the owners of all the property abutting upon the above entitled cement sidewalk improvement district, petitioning the construction of a regulation cement sidewalk therein, waiving advertising or calling for bids, notices of intention to make said improvements, or notices of any kind, and waiving the right of remonstrance, and ratifying and approving all acts and things to be done by the Common Council in connection with the making of said improvement and consenting to assessments being levied as liens against the property of the respective Petitioners for the cost of said improvement, waiving all irregularities in levying of said assessments, and agreeing to pay therefor or bonding the same, and

WHEREAS the Council deems it proper, expedient and for the best interests of the City that said cement sidewalk in said cement sidewalk improvement district be built,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City Engineer make plans, specifications and estimates of said improvement and the cost thereof, in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Lebanon; that said plans, specifications and estimates set forth and state the probable cost of said work and material against each separate lot or tract or parcel of land, and the amount thereof to be born by each parcel; and that said plans, specifications and estimates be filed with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon at the earliest possible date.
