R E S O L U T I O N
No. 1 for 1945

WHEREAS, the owners of all the premises abutting upon the above entitled street improvement district have filed with the Common Council a Petition asking for the grading of said alley to the proper sub-grade and by graveling a roadway in the center thereof with crushed rock or gravel of sufficient thickness to make a permanent all-weather road, and have agreed to pay for the cost of said graveling and other expenses of so improving said alley, except for the grading, which is to be paid for by the City, and

WHEREAS, said Petitioners have waived notice of intention to make said improvements, without advertising or calling for bids and without further notice of any kind, and do ratify and approve all acts and things done or to be done in connection with the making of said improvement by the City of Lebanon, and

WHEREAS, the said improvement appears to be necessary and proper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said street improvement district be and the same is hereby approved, and that the City of Lebanon proceed to improve said alley as in said Petition requested, to-wit: by grading said alley to a proper sub-grade and by graveling the roadway 8 feet wide in the center thereof with crushed rock or gravel of sufficient thickness to make a permanent all-weather road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the cost of said grading be borne by the City and the ~~rest of the~~ remaining cost of said improvement be charged to the abutting premises and made a lien
