


RESOLUTION NO. 18 FOR 1946

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Lebanon by its Common Council make it a matter of record that said body approves the plan of the United States Army Engineers to construct multiple dams on the tributaries of the South Santiam River in connection with the Willamette River Flood Control Project, instead of one large dam on the main stream of the South Santiam River.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be filed as an exhibit at the hearing to be held on the proposition by the United States Army Engineers on or about November 9th, 1946.
