

RESOLUTION NO. 10 FOR 1947


SECTION 1. That not to exceed twelve citizens of Lebanon approved by the Lebanon Auxiliary police and whose names who are on file with the city recorder, are hereby appointed special police to serve at the will of the Council and subject to the direction of the organization known as the Lebanon Auxiliary Police in accordance with the rules of said organization approved by the Council.

SECTION 2. That said police shall perform their duties as extra police of the City only when called to duty in accordance with the rules of the Lebanon Auxiliary Police or by the Mayor or Chief of Police, and shall draw compensation of \$1.00 per hour only while on duty.

SECTION 3. That said special police shall be subject to all the State laws and City Ordinances governing the conduct of police of this City.


It being necessary to have auxiliary police subject to call, in addition to the regular police of the City of Lebanon, this Ordinance is for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Lebanon, and an emergency is therefore hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
