

RESOLUTION 19A for 1947.

Be it resolved that the city of Lebanon borrow from the First National Bank of Lebanon, Oregon, \$14,000 at such rate of interest as may be agreed upon for the purpose of paying the damages assessed to the City by virtue of taking certain parcels of real property for the extension of Park Street and the widening of South Main Street, and that the Cities warrant be issued to said bank therefore.
