

RESOLUTION # 18 FOR 1948

WHEREAS, The Council deems it advisable to prepare for the construction of certain main trunk drainage sewers in the City of Lebanon, so that there shall be no delay in the start of construction when the same is authorized and,

WHEREAS, A general survey of the grades of the City has indicated that certain main trunk drainage sewer lines will be necessary and proper to be built for the drainage of certain areas of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Engineers, Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield, now in the employ be and they are hereby authorized to prepare plans, specifications and estimates of the cost of construction of the following main trunk drainage sewer lines, to-wit:

7th and Tangent Streets,
generally Northerly Southern Pacific right-of-way between Hiatt and Cleveland Streets to the Lebanon & Santiam Canal and Northerly from Elmore Street East of Main Street to the Lebanon & Santiam Canal

as shown on the map heretofore prepared by said Engineers.
