RESOLUTION 2/1948

WHEREAS an audit of the books of the City Recorder has disclosed a deficit for which George H. Randgell, the former City Recorder, has accepted responsibility in the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$1,200.00), and has offered to pay One Thousand Eighty Three and 33/100 Dollars (\$1,083.33) in cash and take credit of One Hundred Sixteen and 67/100 Dollars (\$116.67) for paid vacation which he did not have during the fiscal year 1947-48; and

WHEREAS it is desirable to settle said matter by accepting said offer; now

THEREFORE, the Mayor and Acting Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized to enter into an "greement with said George H. Randell to accept the payment of One Thousand Eighty Three and 33/100 Dollars (\$1,083.33) and give credit of One Hundred Sixteen and 67/100 Dollars (\$116.67) for unused vacation pay, in settlement of said claim and release by the City of said George H. Randall for all shortages to the date of his resignation, to-wit, August 3, 1948.
