

In the Matter of a Drainage District  
for the drainage of the following  
described area of the City of Lebanon,  
to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of  
the center line of Olive Street and  
Fourth Street, thence South along the  
center line of Fourth Street to the  
center line of the S. P. Railroad  
track, thence in a southeasterly  
direction along the center line of  
S. P. Railroad track to a point 162  
feet North of the center line of  
\*ose Street, thence East along the  
North side of Lot 7 and Lot 3, Block  
17 Ralstons Third Addition and the  
North line of Lot 7, Block 16 Ralston's  
Second Addition to the center line of  
the alley in Block 16, thence North  
along the center line of said alley  
projected to a point due West of the  
Center line of Carolina Street pro-  
jected, thence East along said center  
line projected to the center line of  
Main Street, thence North along center  
line of Main Street to a point 230 feet  
North of intersection of center line  
of Main Street and Wheeler Street,  
thence West on a line parallel to  
center line of Morton Street projected  
to the center line of Main Street,  
thence North along the center line  
of Main Street to the center line of  
Olive Street, thence West along said  
center line to the place of beginning.

RESOLUTION # 24

FOR 1949

RESOLUTION APPROVING  
PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS

WHEREAS, for the past several years the facilities for  
draining off the surface waters from the area above described  
have been inadequate and a portion of said water has drained  
into the sanitary sewer, and during periods of heavy rain the  
sanitary sewers have been inadequate to dispose of the sanitary  
sewage and drain waters, and, as a result of this, the waters  
backed from the sanitary sewer into the streets creating an  
unsanitary condition and constituting a menace to the health  
of the residents living within the area above described, and

WHEREAS, a main trunk line has been constructed for  
the purpose of draining the surface waters from this area, and  
in order to provide the necessary drainage it is necessary  
that lateral drainage lines be constructed and it is for the  
best interests of the property owners and citizens residing

upon the property abutting upon the streets within said area that these laterals be constructed, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has made a study of the topography of the City of Lebanon, and has determined the area required to be drained, in order to properly prepare said streets and adjoining streets upon which there probably will be petitions for paving; and has recommended that the above described area is the proper area for drainage in order to accomplish the same in the most efficient and inexpensive manner,


WHEREAS, the owners of property abutting upon said streets will be specially benefitted by the construction of lateral sewers which will carry off the surface waters, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council should, and does hereby, declare the above described area<sup>to</sup> be the necessary and proper area of the City to be drained at this time, and the drainage of the streets in said district to be necessary and proper and for the best interest of the owners of property abutting upon the streets to be drained; and hereby adopts said described area as a drainage district which shall be hereafter known as Drainage District # 6.


Be it further resolved that the plans, specifications and estimates for the drainage of said district filed by the City Engineer be and the same, are hereby approved and adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder shall cause notice of intention to make said improvements in the manner provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon.
