RESOLUTION APPROVING  
PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS

WHEREAS, The City Engineer has filed herein plans, specifications and estimates in the matter of graveling of Berry Street from the East line of Main Street to the West line of Hiatt Street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said plans, specifications and estimates, including the probably total cost of said graveling, and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof to be borne by the City, be and they hereby are in all respects approved, ratified, and affirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said improvements are and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for the best interest of the City of Lebanon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder shall cause such notice of intention to make said improvement to be given as provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon, said notice to be given by posting notice thereof in five public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper in the City of Lebanon, Oregon for a period of ten days.

P E T I T I O N

TO THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON:

We, the undersigned petitioners, being the owners of more than one-half of the real property abutting upon and to be especially benefitted by the hereinafter proposed street improvements, do hereby respectfully petition and ask your honorable body to improve the following street or streets in the manner hereinafter requested, to-wit:

That said improvements be made by grading said street to the proper subgrade and filling as may be necessary and thereafter gravelled in such manner as your honorable body shall specify, it being understood that such gravelling shall extend from curb to curb.

That the cost of said grading and filling shall be borne by the City of Lebanon, and the cost of the gravelling shall be paid by the respective property owners abutting thereon, the same being the property especially benefitted thereby.

That your petitioners respectfully represent and show that said streets are of general use and that it is proper, expedient and for the best interest of the people of the City of Lebanon that said improvements be made as herein requested.

That your petitioners further request that said improvements be made as soon as practicable and that you make said improvements or cause the same to be made without advertising or calling for bids therefore and without any notice of intention to make the same or any further notice of any kind of making said improvements if and where the same can be done in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Lebanon, and we hereby waive the right of remonstrance and hereby ratify and approve all acts and things done or to be done by the Common Council in connection with the making of said improvements, and we hereby consent to assessments being levied as liens against the respective parcels of real property for the cost of the respective improvements hereby requested and we do hereby expressly waive all irregularities in the levying of assessments therefor, or any thereof, and we each agree that we shall, within then (10) days after the assessments are so levied, pay the same or duly execute a bonding application under the Bancroft Bonding Act.
