9 feet of Filbert Avenue between Milton

RESOLUTION NO. 37
FOR 1949
RESOLUTION INITIATING
THE VACATION OF FILBERT
AVENUE, AND SETTING
TIME FOR HEARING AND
DIRECTING THAT NOTICE OF
HEARING BE PUBLISHED.

WHEREAS, all of the owners of the property abutting upon
Filbert Avenue between Milton Street and Elmore Street have
petitioned the Council for the vacation of the West nine feet
of even width of said street, and

WHEREAS, Geo. E. Mitsch and Eleanor H. Mitsch, husband and
wife have tendered a deed to the City for the purpose of adding
fifteen feet to the East side of the present street, so that upon
the vacation of said portion of said street, and the acceptance
of said deed, the street will be six feet wider than at present,
and


WHEREAS, the moving of said street will avoid the removal
of a row of valuable filbert trees, and

WHEREAS, said street is not now in line with any other
street, and moving the same will not cause any job or offset in
an existing street with which Filbert Avenue connects, and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the West 9 feet of
Filbert Avenue between Milton and Elmore Streets in the City
of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon should be vacated and that the
6th day of December, 1949 be fixed as a time for a formal hearing
upon this matter and that the City Recorder be authorized, and she
is hereby directed to cause notice to be given of such hearing by
publication in the Lebanon Express, the City Official newspaper,
once each week for four consecutive weeks, which said notice
shall described the street to be vacated, the date when
the matter of such vacation together with any objections or
remonstrance thereto, which may be made in writing, and filed
with the City Recorder at any time prior to the time of the
hearing, will be heard and considered. That the Recorder be
further directed to post or cause to be posted at or near each

end of the proposed vacation a copy of said notice which shall be headed "Notice of Street Vacation."
