PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS


WHEREAS, the City Engineer has filed herein plans,
specifications and estimates for the laying of an six inch
Lateral Sewer, and the cost thereof, beginning at the end of
the present sewer in the alley in Block 2, Queen Ann Addition
at a point approximately East from the N. E. corner of Lot 4
in said block, running thence South in said alley to a manhole
to be constructed about North 20 feet and East 6 feet from the
S. E. corner of Lot 11 in said block, in the City of Lebanon,
Linn County, Oregon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said plans,
specifications and estimates, including the probable total cost
of said improvements, and the amount thereof to be borne and paid
by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being
the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount
thereof to be borne by the City, be and they hereby are in all
respects approved, ratified and affirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said improvements are
and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for
the best interest of the City of Lebanon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the City Recorder shall
cause such notice of intention to make said improvements to
be given as provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon,
said notice to be given by posting notice thereof in five
public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period
of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper
in the City of Lebanon, Oregon for a period of ten Days.
