RESOLUTION NO.4 FOR1949

RESOLUTION ORDERING SIDE-  
WALK TO BE REBUILT

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets has reported in writing to the City Council that the sidewalk on the South side of Tangent Street running West from the West line of the Southern Pacific Railway right of way *to the West line of the property owned by the Fir Ridge Lumber Co. as extended* should be re-built and the owner of the property abutting upon said sidewalk has been notified that the same should be repaired or re-built and has neglected to do so.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That the Fir Ridge Lumber Company be and it is hereby ordered to re-build the sidewalk on the South side of Tangent Street running west from the west line of the Southern Pacific Railway right of way *to the West line of the property owned by the Fir Ridge Lumber Co. as extended*, within fourteen (14) days from the date of this resolution, said sidewalk to be constructed of cement and in accordance with the specifications set forth in Ordinance No. 586 of the City of Lebanon, relating to the construction of cement sidewalks.


(2) That the Superintendent of Streets be and he is hereby directed within five (5) days after the passage of this resolution to post a notice adjacent to the sidewalk ordered to be re-built which notice shall be headed "Notice To Build Sidewalk", in letters not less than 1/2 inch in length and shall direct the owner of said property to build or repair such sidewalk within the time specified in this resolution.

(3) That the City Recorder be and she is hereby directed within five (5) days from the date of this resolution to send, by mail, a notice to the Fir Ridge Lumber Company to re-build such sidewalk.

(4) That if the Fir Ridge Lumber Company shall fail, neglect, or refuse to re-build such sidewalk within the time ordered by the Council the Superintendent of Streets be and he is hereby ordered to re-build the same, keep an accurate account of the costs of labor and materials in building such sidewalk, and to report, upon the completion of such sidewalk, the costs of the labor and materials employed in re-building the same, and the description of the property fronting upon said sidewalk.

(5) That if the sidewalk is re-built by the Superintendent of Streets, the City Attorney be instructed after the report, showing the cost of such work has been submitted to the Council, be ordered to prepare an Ordinance levying an assessment upon the property fronting on such sidewalk for the amount of the costs thereof, and submit the same to the Council for their approval or rejection.
