RESOLUTION NO. 25 FOR 1950


WHEREAS, the Lanham Housing Act, War Housing Project ORE. 35268 under Federal control and Veterans Re-Use Housing Project No. V35364 under control of the City of Lebanon are to be discontinued before January 1, 1951 and it is necessary in order to avoid a housing shortage that the City purchase the projects and operate them until such time as there no longer exists a housing shortage, and

WHEREAS, the land upon which the houses are located will, after the houses have been removed be valuable to the City for recreational sites and it will be for the best interests of the City that the houses and the land be purchased for the purpose of currently relieving the housing shortage and ultimately providing sites for needed recreational facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Lebanon, by and through the Chairman of the Public Property Committee, make application to the Federal Public Housing Administration for the purchase of the land owned by the Federal Government included within both of said housing projects and for the acquisition of the houses located on project Ore. 35268.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City will, if the land and houses are conveyed and transferred to it, comply with all of the provisions and propositions contained in the pamphlet by the Public Housing Administration issued on June 8, 1950 entitled, "Information Concerning the Transfer of Temporary Public Housing to Local Bodies Pursuant to the Housing Act of 1950," in so far as the same relate to the acquisition by the City of Lebanon of the land and houses requested.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 18th day of July, 1950.
