RESOLUTION NO. 28 FOR 1950

WHEREAS street improvements have been made upon Ash Street abutting upon the following described street:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 37 Cotton's Addition to Lebanon, and running thence South to the Southeast corner of said lot, thence East to the Southwest corner of Lot 6 Block 32 in said addition, thence North to the Northwest corner of said Lot 6, thence West to the place of beginning.

which said street is not now being used, and it is the judgment of the Council that said street should be sold as soon as possible to pay the cost of such improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Public Property Committee be authorized to take whatever steps are required to sell said street, or if such cannot be sold and in their judgment they deem it wise to vacate said street to proceed with such vacation.
