IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO INSTITUTE A SUIT AT LAW TO RESTRAIN EVERETT WIGGINS FROM INTERFERING WITH THE SWIMMING POOL

RESOLUTION NO. 10 FOR 1952

WHEREAS, a dispute has arisen between Everett L. Wiggins and Union High School District No. 1, Linn County, Oregon, and the City of Lebanon, concerning the right of Everett L. Wiggins to interfere with the swimming pool located on the Lebanon High School grounds and,

WHEREAS, an announcement has been made to the public that the pool will be open on July 1 and continuously thereafter and it is necessary that court action be taken to prevent Wiggins from interfering with the preparations for the opening of the pool.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to institute a suit at law for the purpose of securing a court order restraning the said Everett L. Wiggins from going upon the swimming pool grounds or in any manner interfering with the preparations for the opening and operation of the pool and for any other purpose connected with the aforesaid dispute which the Mayor deems advisable.
