RESOLUTION NO. 1 FOR 1952

WHEREAS the City of Lebanon has heretofore withdrawn from the Public Employees Retirement System of the State of Oregon and as a result thereof the employees of the City of Lebanon are no longer covered by old age insurance, and,

WHEREAS all of the eligible employees of the City of Lebanon, have by statement under oath, requested coverage in the Federal Social Security Program and it is the judgment of the City Council that application should be made for participation therein.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Lebanon make application for participation in the Social Security Program provided for by Public Law 734 enacted by the 81st Congress in August, 1950 and that the City Recorder be and she is hereby authorized and directed to apply to the Public Employees Retirement Board, Social Security Administration for necessary forms for such participation.
