

VESTING IN THE POLICE)
COMMITTEE POWER TO)
REMOVE POLICEMEN.)

RESOLUTION NO. 4
FOR 1952

WHEREAS the City Council has by Ordinance No. 837, relating to the removal of members of the police force, provided that this power may by resolution be vested in the committee on police and Health, subject to confirmation by the Council, and,

WHEREAS at this time it is the just ground of the Council that the Committee on Police and Health, and Marshall, are more familiar with the membership and operation of the police force and that vesting in the authority to remove members will lead to increase the efficiency of the force.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Committee on Police and Health shall have and is hereby vested with the power and authority to remove any members of the Police force with the exception of the Marshall and Assistance Chief of Police in the manner provided by Ordinance No. 837. This authorization may be delegated by the Committee on Police and Health to the Marshall.
