RESOLUTION NO. 13

FOR 1953

WHEREAS, the tract of land hereinafter described has been dedicated to the public for the use of a pathway between Jennings Street and Berry Street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS it is the judgement of the Council that public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacation of said tract of land, and that the same is no longer needed as a public thoroughfare.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the following described tract of land, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 17, McDaniel's Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and running thence North along the East line of Lot 17 and Lot 14 in said Addition, to a point South 5 feet from the Northeast corner of said lot 14, thence East parallel with the South line of Berry St. 5 feet to a point on the West line of Lot 13, which is South 5 feet from the Northwest corner of last said lot, thence South along the West line of Lots 13 and 18 in said Addition to the Southwest corner of said Lot 18, thence West 5 feet to the place of beginning, the same being a pathway dedicated to the public as shown by the plat of McDaniel's Addition now of record in the office of the Recorder of conveyances for Linn County, Oregon.

should be vacated, and that the 19th day of January ,1954
be fixed as a time for a formal hearing upon this matter and
that the City Recorder be authorized, and she is hereby
directed to cause notice to be given of such hearing by
publication in the Lebanon Express, the City official newspaper,
once each week for four consecutive weeks, which said notice
shall describe the street to be vacated, the date when
the matter of such vacation together with any objections or
remonstrance thereto, which may be made in writing, and filed
with the City Recorder at any time prior to the time of the
hearing, will be heard and considered. That the Recorder be
further directed to post or cause to be posted at or near each
end of the proposed vacation, a copy of said notice which shall
be headed "Notice of Street Vacation".
