RESOLUTION NO. 14

FOR 1953

WHEREAS, the tract of land hereinafter described has been dedicated to the public for the use of a pathway between Isabella Street and Carolina Street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS it is the judgement of the Council that public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacation of said tract of land, and that the same is no longer needed as a public throughfare.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the following described tract of land, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 2 of the Supplemental Plat of Lots 4 to 7 inclusive, Block 4 Kirkpatrick's Third Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; thence running North 89 degrees 52' East, 3 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 3 in said supplemental plat, thence South 0 degrees 10' East along the West line of said lot 3 to the Southwest corner thereof; thence South 0 degrees 10' East along said lot 3 produced to the North line of Isabella Street; thence South 89 degrees 52' West along said street line 3 feet; thence North 0 degrees 10' West to the place of beginning.

should be vacated, and that the 19th day of *January*, 1951~~4~~ be fixed as a time for a formal hearing upon this matter and that the City Recorder be authorized, and she is hereby directed to cause notice to be given of such hearing by publication in the Lebanon Express, the City official newspaper, once each week for four consecutive weeks, which said notice shall describe the street to be vacated, the date when the matter of such vacation together with any objections or remonstrance thereto, which may be made in writing, and filed with the City Recorder at any time prior to the time of the hearing, will be heard and considered. That the Recorder be further directed to post or cause to be posted at or near each end of the proposed vacation, a copy of said notice which shall be headed "Notice of Street Vacation".
